**Autumn II Term** (7 Weeks : October 11th to December 3rd, 2021)

Each of the 10 courses is tailored to the level of expertise and type of study required by students. Weekly lessons provide students with an opportunity to begin the study of Japanese or to sharpen previously acquired skills. - Beginning Japanese Level I** **Friday evenings 5:30-7:30pm**  
 Designed for students with no previous instruction in Japanese, this course strives to develop an understanding of basic elements of Japanese grammar, expressions, and writing system. Textbooks: *Japanese For Busy People, Vol. I, and Workbook Vol. I.*
- Beginning Japanese Level II** **Monday evenings 5:30-7:30pm**  
 A continuation of Beginning Japanese Level I, this course will build upon previously learned basic elements of Japanese grammar and expressions. Writing system will include a review of katakana, hiragana, and an introduction to basic Chinese characters (Kanji). Textbooks: *Japanese For Busy People, Vol. I, Workbook Vol. I, and Kanji book Vol. I.*
- Beginning Japanese Level III** **Thursday evenings 7:30-9:30pm**  
 A continuation of Beginning Japanese Level II, this course will build upon previously learned basic elements of Japanese grammar and expressions. Textbooks: *Japanese For Busy People, Vol. I, Workbook Vol. I, and Kanji book Vol. I.*
- Beginning Japanese Level IV** **Friday evenings 7:30-9:30pm**  
 A continuation of Beginning Japanese Level III, this course will build upon previously learned basic elements of Japanese grammar and expressions. Textbooks: *Japanese For Busy People, Vol. I, Workbook Vol. I, and Kanji book Vol. I.*
- Intermediate Japanese Level I** **Monday evenings 7:30-9:30pm**  
 A continuation of Beginning Japanese Level IV, Class to include reading projects and group discussion on Japanese culture and customs. Textbooks: *Japanese For Busy People, Vol. II, Workbook Vol. II, and Kanji book Vol. I.*
- Intermediate Japanese Level II** **Wednesday evenings 7:30-9:30pm**  
 A continuation of Intermediate Japanese Level I. Class to include reading projects and group discussion on Japanese culture and customs. Textbooks: *Japanese For Busy People, Vol. II, Workbook Vol. II, and Kanji book Vol. I.*
- Intermediate Japanese Level III** **Thursday evenings 5:30-7:30pm**  
 A continuation of Intermediate Japanese Level II. Class to include reading projects and group discussion on Japanese culture and customs. Textbooks: *Japanese For Busy People, Vol. II, Workbook Vol. II, and Kanji book Vol. I.*
- Conversational Japanese Level I** **Tuesday evenings 5:30-7:30pm**  
 A continuation of Intermediate Japanese Level III. This class will provide a forum for basic Japanese conversation between students and instructor. Topics of conversation will be determined by the instructor, along with various reading assignments. Textbooks: *Japanese for Busy People, Vol. III, Workbook Vol. III, Kanji book Vol. II* and various handouts.
- Conversational Japanese Level II** **Tuesday evenings 7:30-9:30pm**  
 A continuation of Conversational Japanese Level I. This class will provide a forum for basic Japanese conversation between students and instructor. Topics of conversation will be determined by the instructor, along with various reading assignments. Textbooks: *Japanese for Busy People, Vol. III, Workbook Vol. III, Kanji book Vol. II* and various handouts.
- Conversational Japanese Level III** **Wednesday evenings 5:30-7:30pm**  
 A continuation of Conversational Japanese Level II. This class will provide a forum for basic Japanese conversation between students and instructor. Topics of conversation will be determined by the instructor, along with various reading assignments. Textbooks: *Communicating in Japanese, Kanji book Vol. II & III* and various handouts.
